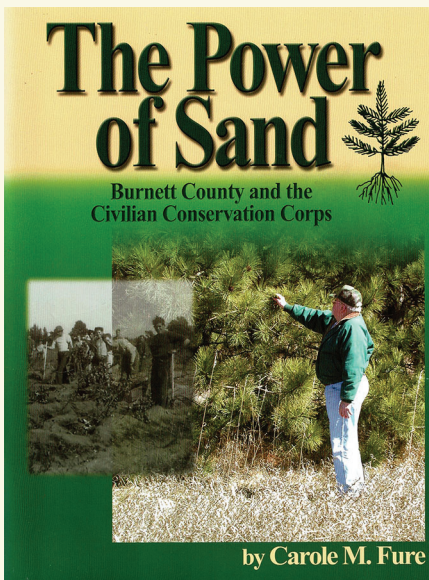

Burnett County and the
Civilian Conservation Corps

Carole, a retired nurse from Marshfield, Wisconsin, enjoys spending her free time quilting and researching family history. Soon after she moved to Burnett County in the 1990s, she began volunteering for the local Historical Society. While there, she had the opportunity to research Riverside, a Civilian Conservation Corp

camp, which was located in the county during the depression. The research unraveled the amazing story of unintended land misuse, its far-reaching consequences and the laborious process of recovery.

The story also highlights how 18-year-old boys impacted the healing process, and how that process of healing the land impacted the boys. The story gives the reader a deeper understanding of how Burnett County came to be the beautiful place that it is today—a land of luscious forests and peaceful lakes.
