



OUR 2021 Summer Reading Program begins on **June 9** and goes on for five weeks (ending July 7th).

This year, we will NOT be meeting in person – we will have weekly Grab and Go Bags available on Wednesdays in the Children’s Reading Room. Annette will be there to hand out the bags and answer question from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. each Wednesday.

There are Grab and Go Bags for ages 3-6 and for ages 7-12.

Here’s what we’ll be doing this summer:

- **June 16: Family Outdoor Scavenger Hunt**
- **June 23: Write Your Family’s Favorite Tail Wagging Story**
- **June 30: Library Scavenger Hunt**
- **July 7: “Check out Fence Painting in Parking Lot” Activity**

Also, this year we are offering BEANSTACK, an app to track your children’s reading. It is not actually a part of this program, but an additional piece to add enjoyment to your child’s summer reading experience. Instructions will be available in another flier.

Each week, we will include instructions for the caregivers with the Grab and Go Bags. We hope you will track your child’s reading on the reading log they will receive the first week. Each week we will include a recommended reading list of books available at our library that complement the weekly theme. While we will be giving out a few incentives, our goal is that the children will enjoy reading for its own sake.
